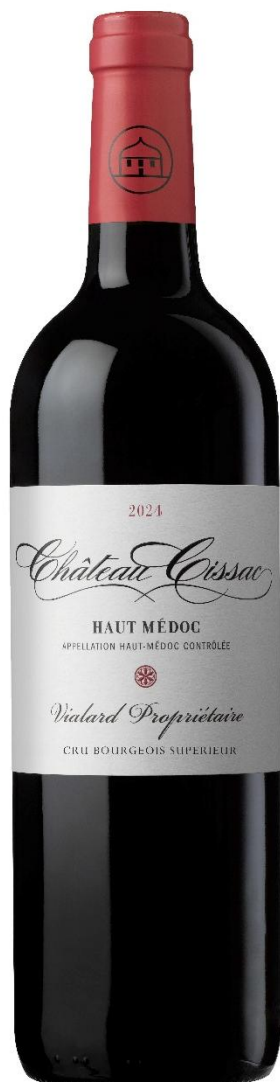

91+ : The vintage 2024 vintage reminds of the great classics from the 80s. Deep purple colour and violet hue. The nose is elegant with aroma reminiscent of blackcurrants, blackcurrant spurs and in the background a whiff of raspberries, aromatic herbs, discreet spices and subtle oak. On the palate well-structured with ripe yet firm tannins, rather medium bodied but with refined aromatic persistence, a wine which will demand some time for evolution but reflecting the Cissac terroir in a very refined way.

YOHAN CASTAING THE WINE ADVOCATE

88-91: The 2024 Cissac is a bit austere and shy, evoking aromas of green bell pepper, spices and licorice. Medium to full-bodied, dense and concentrated, it's structured with firm tannins that lead to an oaky finish with lead pencil inflections. It could chill out with 1-2 years in the cellar. This is a blend of 61% Cabernet Sauvignon, 29% Merlot, 10% Petit Verdot and 2% Malbec.
