Winemaking Clusters are meticulously hand-sorted, followed by gentle destemming and precise optical sorting to select only the finest whole berries. The grapes are gravity-fed into vats or oak vessels and undergo a five-day cold soak to preserve their pure fruity aromas. Extraction is carried out with pump-overs and some punch-downs during fermentation. After 30 days in tank, the wine is drained and pressed into new French oak barrels, where a natural malolactic fermentation gracefully unfolds.
