SINE FINE by Benoit Touquette

The great poet from Tang Dynasty Po Chü-i writes:

On high, we'd be two love birds flying wing to wing, On earth, two trees with branches twined from spring to spring.

Inseparable birds are a classic symbol of love and intimacy in Chinese culture. With one set of wings, the blue bird and the red bird are bound together forever, and will never separate. Like the birds, the intense passion and love of our newlywed friend Benoit Touquette has been beautifully translated into this wine.

VINTAGE NOTES

2019 had a warmer, sunnier growing season, and winemakers focused their efforts on preserving all that purity of fruit and freshness in the wines. Without extreme heat or rain to work around, it was a less hurried season. Dry winds and low humidity led to minor berry dehydration, concentrating sugars and flavors.

Harvesting slightly earlier than in 2018, the 2019 vintage yielded wines that are more generous and weightier, with slightly higher alcohol and less acidity.

TASTING NOTES

Vibrant blue and black fruits evolve into a deep core with roasted herbs, dark chocolate, graphite, and tobacco notes. This rich, full-bodied wine is seamlessly layered, offering a supple mid-palate and a lingering finish. The wine presents a blend of purity, elegance, richness, and depth.

When it rouses itself and flies, its wings obscure the sky like clouds.

A symbol of incredible strength and magnitude, K'un represents Thomas's wine, Perihelios.



For optimal enjoyment, cellar it for 5-7 years to unlock its full potential, where it will reward with two to three decades of superb drinking experience.

TRINICEROS by Michel Rolland

Michel Rolland blends Fairest Creature's flagship wine by picking the best barrel selection from each of our three renowned winemakers. It is only available en magnum and is extremely limited in production.

Triniceros is derived from the Latin roots trini (three) and ceros (horns), and symbolizes the three virtuosos behind this wine. His image is modeled after the Qilin, a revered creature from Chinese mythology that represents good fortune and wisdom. This hybrid beast has the head of a dragon, the body of a tiger or a deer, and an ox's tail.

VINTAGE NOTES

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Harvesting slightly earlier than in 2018, the 2019 vintage yielded wines that are more generous and weightier, with slightly higher alcohol and less acidity.

TASTING NOTES

This wine presents a captivating blend of red and black fruits, showcasing remarkable complexity with notes of tobacco, toasted spices, herbal nuances, and hints of lead pencil. Its profound richness and opulence are complemented by flawless balance, velvety yet wellstructured tannins, a generous mouthfeel, and an astonishingly enduring finish. It is a wine of exceptional quality that can be enjoyed at any time over the next two to two and a half decades.
