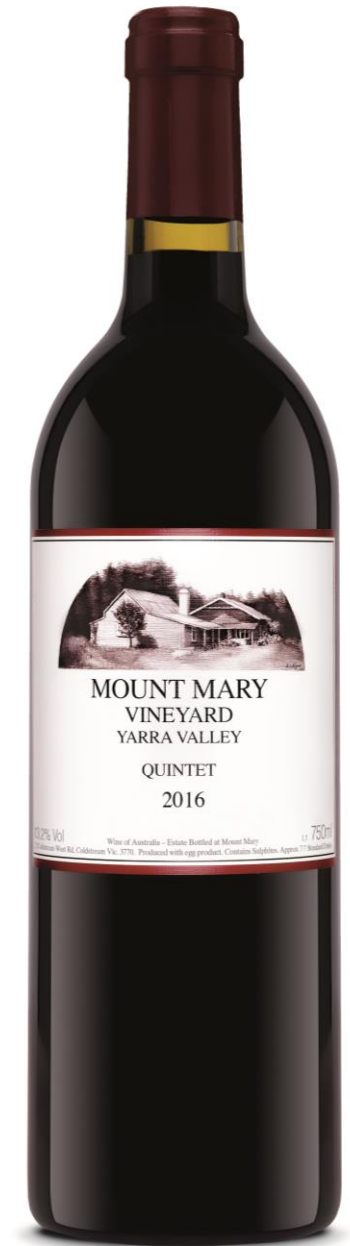

The name of 'Armagh' was bestowed by the original Irish settlers who arrived in 1849, and named after the lush rolling hills of their homeland. The vineyard was planted by Jim Barry in 1968 and yields less than two tonnes per acre."

The Mount Edelstone Vineyard was planted in 1912 by Ronald Angas, a descendant of George Fite Angas who founded The South Australian Company and played a significant role in the formation and establishment of South Australia. Crafted by the Henschke family for over 65 years now, Mount Edelstone is arguably the longest consecutively-produced, single-vineyard wine in Australia." - Henschke
